

**NEW MEXICO FEDERATION OF REPUBLICAN WOMEN
SCHOLARSHIP**

PURPOSE:

The NMFRW scholarship has been established to assist a deserving female student from New Mexico to further her education at a college, university or vocational school in New Mexico.

DESCRIPTION:

The NMFRW scholarship is a \$1000 cash award for first place and \$500 cash award for second place given to a woman from New Mexico. The amount of the scholarship will be \$500 for first place and \$250 for second place for the fall semester following the awarding of the scholarship. A like amount will be awarded for the second semester contingent upon successful completion of Funding Provision #3 under Funding Procedures.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A recipient must:

1. Be a resident of New Mexico.
 2. Be a registered Republican or the daughter of a registered Republican if under the age of 18.
 3. Be a member of the graduating class and accepted for enrollment in an institution of higher learning in New Mexico in the year in which she applies (home schoolers are eligible for consideration)
- OR**
4. Be enrolled as a full time student at a college, university or vocational school in New Mexico
 5. Have a 3.0 or better scholastic average based on a 4.0 system
 6. Plan to study government, political science, international relations or history. Consideration will be given to participation in political activities.

STIPULATIONS:

1. There will be no discrimination due to race, creed or color in the selection of the recipient.
2. Selection of a recipient will be made by a committee selected by NMFRW.
3. The high school or institute of higher learning will certify that the recipient has fulfilled the requirements and is eligible for the award.
4. Announcement of the recipient will be made by a member of the committee to the respective high school or institute of higher learning.
5. Application must be made through a local unit of the NMFRW.

FUNDING PROCEDURES:

1. The recipient must enroll in a sufficient number of hours to qualify as a full-time college freshman or full-time student at a college, university, or vocational school.
2. Payment of the scholarship, to the student's account, will be made by NMFRW directly to the registrar or director of admissions of the school to which the recipient has been accepted or is enrolled for credit.
3. A matching amount will be credited to the student's account at the beginning of the second semester upon verification from school officials that the student has maintained at least 2.5 grade point average based on a 4.0 system and completed sufficient number of hours to qualify as a full-time student for the second semester.
4. The recipient will be responsible for notifying and providing verification to the NMFRW for the second semester payment.
5. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, room, board, books, tools, school fees or other enrollment requirement.
